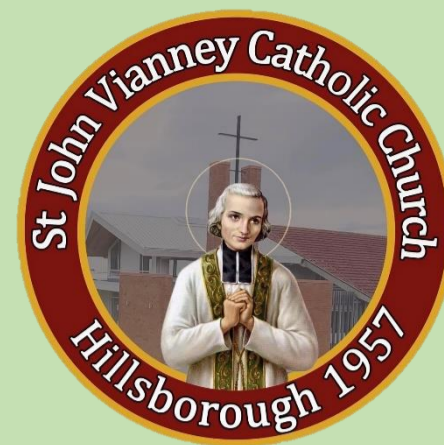

1st Reading: Acts 2:1-11
Psalm 46 God mounts his throne to shouts of Joy; a blare of trumpets for the Lord.


2nd Reading: Galatians 5:16-25
Gospel: John 15:26-27,16:12-15

The Spirit of truth will lead you to the complete truth.

Jesus said to his disciples:
 'When the Advocate comes, whom I shall send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth who issues from the Father, he will be my witness. And you too will be witnesses, because you have been with me from the outset. 'I still have many things to say to you but they would be too much for you now. But when the Spirit of truth comes he will lead you to the complete truth, since he will not be speaking as from himself but will say only what he has learnt; and he will tell you of the things to come. He will glorify me, since all he tells you will be taken from what is mine. Everything the Father has is mine; that is why I said: All he tells you will be taken from what is mine.'
